DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Oversee and align supply chain functions to support production and customer delivery goals.
- Lead teams in Purchasing, Shipping, and Customer Service to ensure seamless operations.
- Ensure accurate Raw Material levels.
- Manage supplier relationships and logistics to optimize cost, quality, and delivery.
- Collaborate with internal departments to support strategic initiatives and continuous improvement.
- Oversee domestic and international shipping operations, ensuring timely and cost-effective delivery of goods.
- Support internal and external audits, including supplier audits and customer quality reviews.
- Evaluating spending operations while seeking ways to improve and enhance the quality of products purchased and the timeliness of deliveries.
- Monitor and analyze supply chain performance metrics.
- Ensure compliance with regulations and quality standards.
- Assessment of customers' needs to meet quality standards.
